READJUSTMENT COUNSELING SERVICES: The Veteran's Center welcomes home war veterans by providing quality readjustment services to veterans and their families.

FLORIDA REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP & TRAINING PROGRAM: Individuals can obtain the necessary training to master a trade while earning a wage.

VETERANS AFFAIRS WORK STUDY PROGRAM: Available to any full-time or ¾ time student in a college degree, vocational or professional program, students can “earn while they learn” with a Veterans Affairs work-study allowance.

VETERANS AFFAIRS CHAPTER 31 VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION & EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM: Assists veterans with service-connected disabilities to achieve employment or enhance their ability to function independently at home and in the community.

DEPENDENTS EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE: Offers up to 45 months of education benefits to eligible dependents of veterans who are permanently and totally disabled due to a service-related condition, or who died while on active duty or as a result of a service-related condition.

SMART START FOR NEW VETERANS: Online jobs program matches ex-enlistees with major corporations in the Southeastern United States. Free and open to all active enlistees who have decided to leave the armed services.
