Most importantly it reinforces the values of empathy, autonomy in decision making, accountability & responsibility in our Student Nurses.





- ▶ The Elderly Compassionate Care, Macedonia Education Technology and Career Academy (METCA) program is a veteran and faith-based program that provides Brevard's low-income members scholarship funds for entry level healthcare training in Home Health Aide (HHA), Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), and Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN) career fields. Upon completion of training and certification, students receive job placement assistance through the support of CareerSource Brevard.





METCA recruits candidates interested in healthcare training from the community.


METCA puts candidates through their TABE Boot Camp to improve academic skills. They also receive information on healthcare careers and soft skills training before they start the Nursing Assistant training program.

METCA provides scholarship resources to make the training accessible to candidates.



- ▶ *METCA allows otherwise disadvantage individuals including Veterans or disabled individuals to pursue a career while preparing them for the challenges of the real world. BNA provides the learning, simulation, and nursing skills necessary to make these goals a reality.*
- ▶ *One partnership collaborated between METCA & BNA is where we partner with Promise of Brevard & First Baptist Church of Cocoa. This program is offered in North Brevard for students who want to pursue the HHA & CNA program but are unable to commute to Palm Bay. We have graduated 9 HHA and 6 CNA program participants.*
- ▶ *By partnering with METCA, BNA finds that students who have completed METCA's program are better equipped to handle the course content. They have not only learned valuable skills which allow them to pass the entrance exam on the first attempt, but they grow into more well-rounded students academically and professionally.*

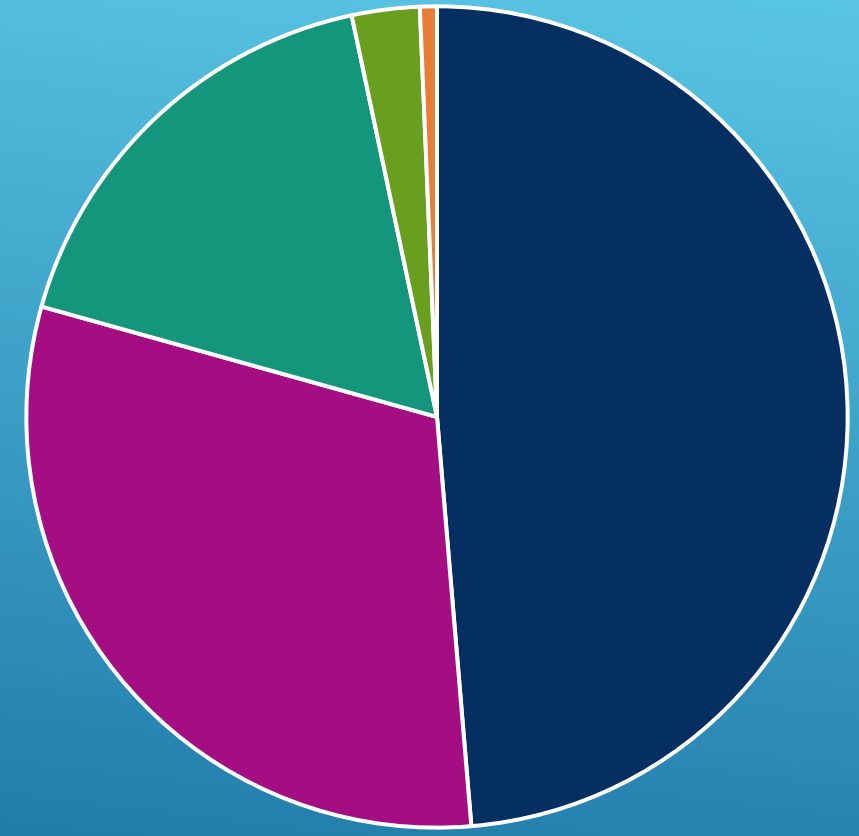

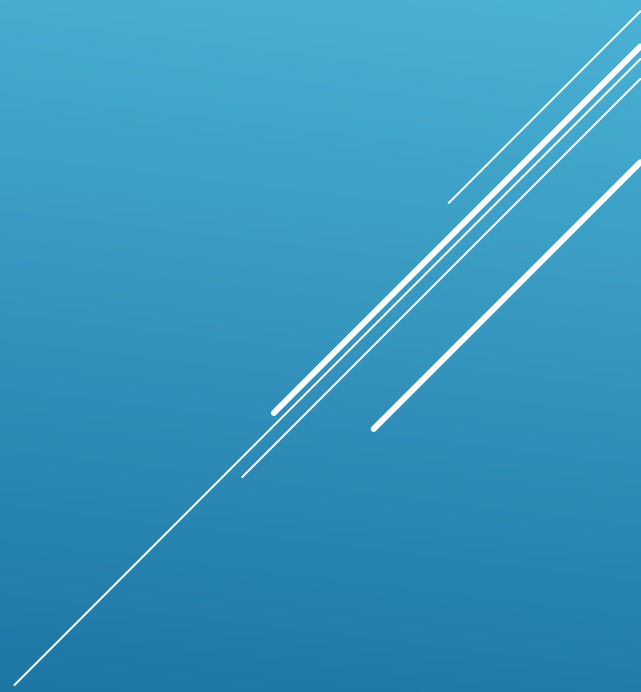




Health First Students
